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Academic Courses: Foundations

English | Math | Science Courses

Suitable for: Year 2-11 | Grade 1-10 Course length: 15 hours

One-on-one: \$13,500 Format: in person or online

These subject-specific courses support primary and secondary school students on English, math and science. Classes are personalized and will follow your child's school curriculum. Reading & Writing Course

Vocabulary Booster Course

Extended Essay (EE)

The Extended Essay (EE) is a 4,000-word research paper that all IB DP students must complete. As a critical part of the final IB score, the EE can be intimidating for many students. Whether students need help formulating an appropriate research question, engaging in a personal exploration of the topic, communicating ideas, and/or developing an argument, we are here to help. Theory of Knowledge (TOK)
